

A Bill to Instill a Maximum Cost of College Attendance

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1 SECTION 1. All public colleges will institute a ceiling on the cost of
2 attendance of \$30,000 per year.
- 3 SECTION 2. Cost of attendance includes, tuition, fees, room and board.
- 4 SECTION 3. The Department of Education will oversee the
5 implementation of this bill. A. Schools which fail to adhere to
6 this ceiling shall not receive Federal loans or grants.
- 7 SECTION 4. Implementation of the bill will begin at the commencement of
8 the 2018-19 academic year.
- 9 SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared
10 null and void.

A Bill to Encourage Bilingual Education Programs

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Department of Education shall make \$2 billion in grants
2 available for states which either currently offer or will commit
3 to the use of bilingual education programs to educate all
4 students not currently proficient in spoken English.
- 5 SECTION 2. Bilingual education programs are those which provide
6 instruction in English as well as the students' spoken
7 languages. This method is used to develop student literacy in
8 both languages.
- 9 SECTION 3. The Department of Education shall administer the grant
10 program. Grants shall be awarded upon demonstrated proof
11 that the state has adopted bilingual education programs as a
12 primary means of English proficiency instruction. Grants may
13 be renewed if the state is able to demonstrate growth on
14 state-based English proficiency assessments. Funding shall be
15 taken from existing Title 1 funding.
- 16 SECTION 4. This shall take effect on September 1, 2019.

A Bill to Ban Artificial Intelligence Crime-Predicting Softwares

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1 SECTION 1. All courts and police departments can no longer use crime-
2 predicting artificial intelligence to justify and influence court
3 rulings.

4 SECTION 2. A. Police departments are defined as all federal and state
5 police departments, including county and district sheriffs.
6 B. Crime-predicting softwares are programs developed using
7 algorithms and artificial intelligence to determine if an
8 individual has an increased likelihood of committing a crime
9 or the probable geographic location of certain crimes
10 C. Courts include federal, state, trial, circuit, district, appeals,
11 and supreme courts.

12 SECTION 3. The Department of Justice will oversee the implementation of
13 this legislation.
14 A. Any police or court systems found to be guilty of not
15 complying with this legislation will be fined \$10,000 per
16 infraction.

17 SECTION 4. This bill will go into effect immediately upon passage.

18 SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared
19 null and void.
