

## **A Resolution to Abolish the Police**

## **A Resolution to Ban TikTok**

**WHEREAS:** TikTok is a Chinese owned company, which allows for the potential of spying on US citizens through usage of the app;

**WHEREAS:** Tensions remain at an all time high with China;

**WHEREAS:** The safety and privacy of US citizens are a priority to the United States;

THEREFORE BE IT

**RESOLVED:** This house here assembled would ban the use of TikTok in the United States.

## **A Bill to Mandate a Centralized Response to Covid-19**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

**SECTION 1:** All further US responses to the Covid-19 virus must originate from the United States federal government.

**SECTION 2:** In order to create a more centralized response to the pandemic, responsibility on dealing with Covid-19 will be handed over to the federal government where they will be allowed to make decisions concerning the US as a whole.

**SECTION 3:** States are permitted to enact greater protections and protocols but must use the federal mandate as a baseline minimum.

**SECTION 4:** The Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) will oversee the enforcement and implementation of this bill.

**SECTION 5:** This legislation shall take effect on September 1, 2020.

**SECTION 6:** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

## **A Bill to Upgrade the US Infrastructure**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

**SECTION 1:** All water utility districts in the United States serving populations of 10,000 or more residents will be required to replace all water mains and secondary piping containing lead as well as aging water mains that have reached the end of their useful lives by 2040.

**SECTION 2:** All water districts will be required to develop and implement long-term plans for the regular replacement of water mains which exceed their expected 90-year life cycles.

**SECTION 3:** Under the direction of the US Environmental Protection Agency, Congress will allocate a minimum of \$2 Billion per fiscal year in the form of state and municipal grants to aid in the upgrading process. Priority for these grants will be:

- A.** Water districts which serve impoverished communities who would be significantly impacted by higher water bills needed to pay for the required upgrades; and
- B.** Utilities serving populations of 10,000 or less residents.

**SECTION 4:** This legislation shall take effect in Fiscal Year 2021.

**SECTION 5:** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
